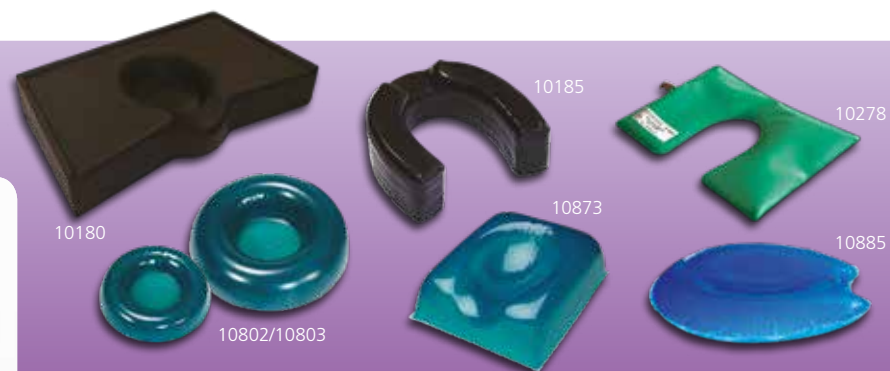

May 14th was National ODP Day – a celebration and promotion of the profession which is set to become an annual event.

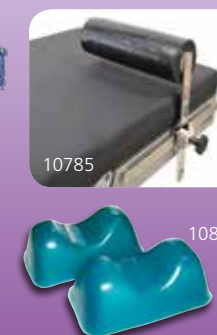
The idea was to 'come out from behind closed theatre doors' and promote the work of ODPs, both to their other healthcare colleagues and to the wider public.

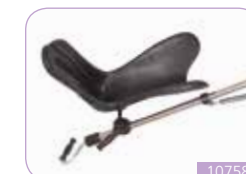

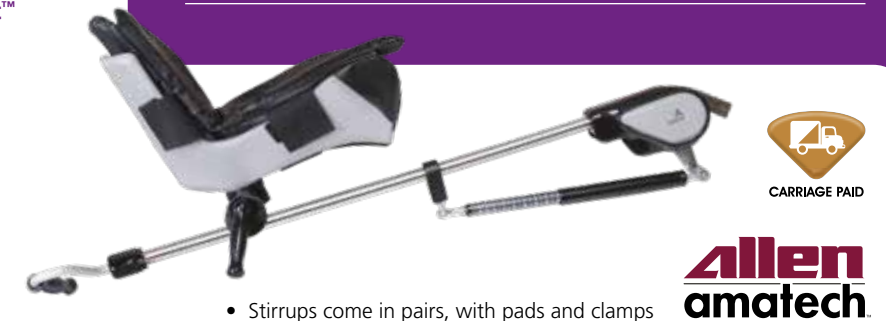

Increased day case throughput at Caerphilly hospital

Ysbyty Ystrad Fawr is Caerphilly Borough's new Local General Hospital and is providing elective surgical services for Aneurin Bevan University Health Board.

It has 269 beds, most in single ensuite bedrooms which helps to provide high quality care, reduce hospital acquired infection rates and give its patients the privacy and dignity they need.

The hospital undertakes several specialities, including General Surgery, ENT, Urology, Gynae and Orthopaedics including being the specialist centre for foot and ankle and hand surgery.

Needing to replace operating tables which were in some cases almost 20 years old, Operating Theatre Manager Darren Beatty led

extensive trials to find the best models for the hospital's three operating theatres. The result was the purchase of first two, and now three of Anetic Aid's QA4 Powered Day Surgery Trolleys.
