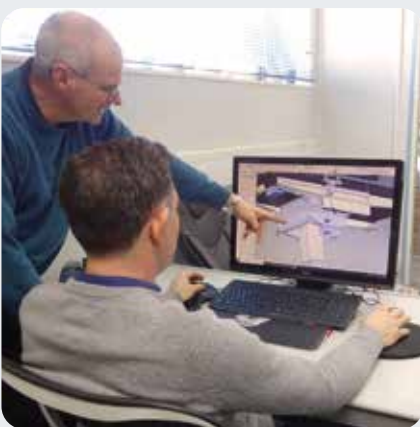

Explained CEO Guy Schofield: ‘We worked closely with the pioneers of day surgery and we have continued to monitor its growing popularity as the range of procedures – particularly those involving keyhole surgery – has grown. Positioning the trolley in lateral tilt is ideal for laparoscopic procedures such as cholecystectomy (gall bladder removal) as it provides fundamentally easier access for the surgeon.

‘Our focus on increased manoeuvrability recognises that day surgery is no longer carried out in dedicated units – it has moved into mainstream theatre. By using the same steer mechanism developed for our latest QA3 patient trolley, we can offer the same ease of use, without expensive development costs.

‘In fact, we have managed to include all of these improvements without increasing the price of the trolley. We have worked hard on refining all aspects of the manufacturing process and value engineering wherever we can to ensure that it continues to give great value for money.’

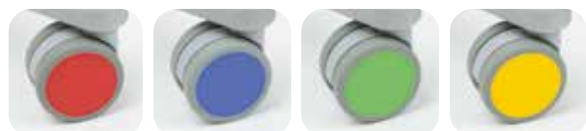

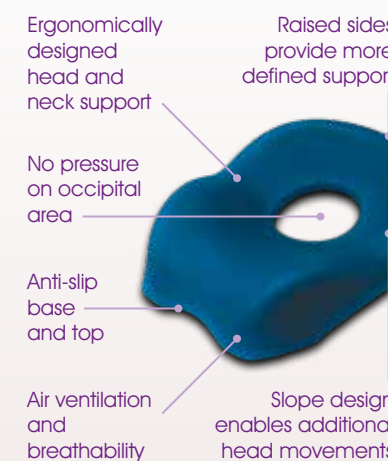

Trees for greening project

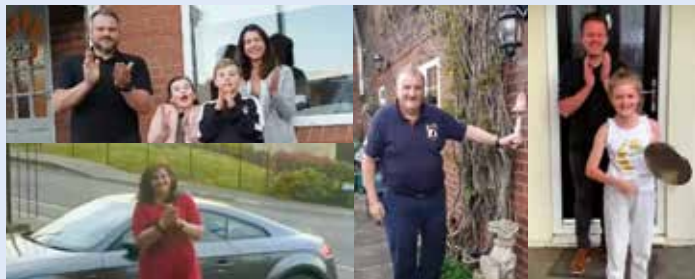
Before lockdown, we supported the Westbourne Greening Project in West Sussex by donating three trees for the village's primary school.
