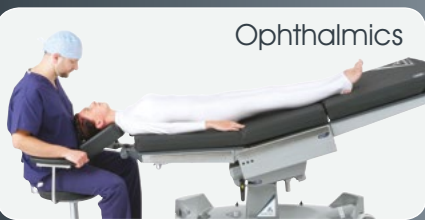

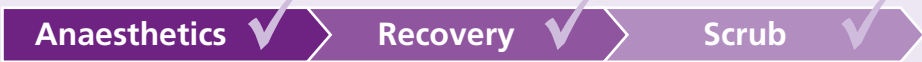
North West team champions formal and transferable qualifications for CPD training in the workplace

Practice-based educators in Greater Manchester are working together to develop a new qualification system that will be recognised by all of the hospitals across their Trusts.

It will mean that practitioners can gain formal recognition for additional skills gained as part of CPD training in the workplace, rather than taking time out to attend college or university courses.

One of the PBEs /Educators behind the scheme is Wythenshawe Hospital's Glen Marmash who explained: 'Our aim is to bring the academic and practical side of skills training together, on site, as this would be a more cost-effective way of providing development – and therefore progression opportunities – for our people.'

'Initially we are planning to develop three modules covering Learning Objectives, Content and Outcomes in the specialisms:



'In the first instance, it will be particularly relevant for nurses looking to gain new skills and further their careers – but once we have the model, we can look at other nursing groups too.'

'It's early days, but we feel it has a lot of potential and we're very excited about it.'

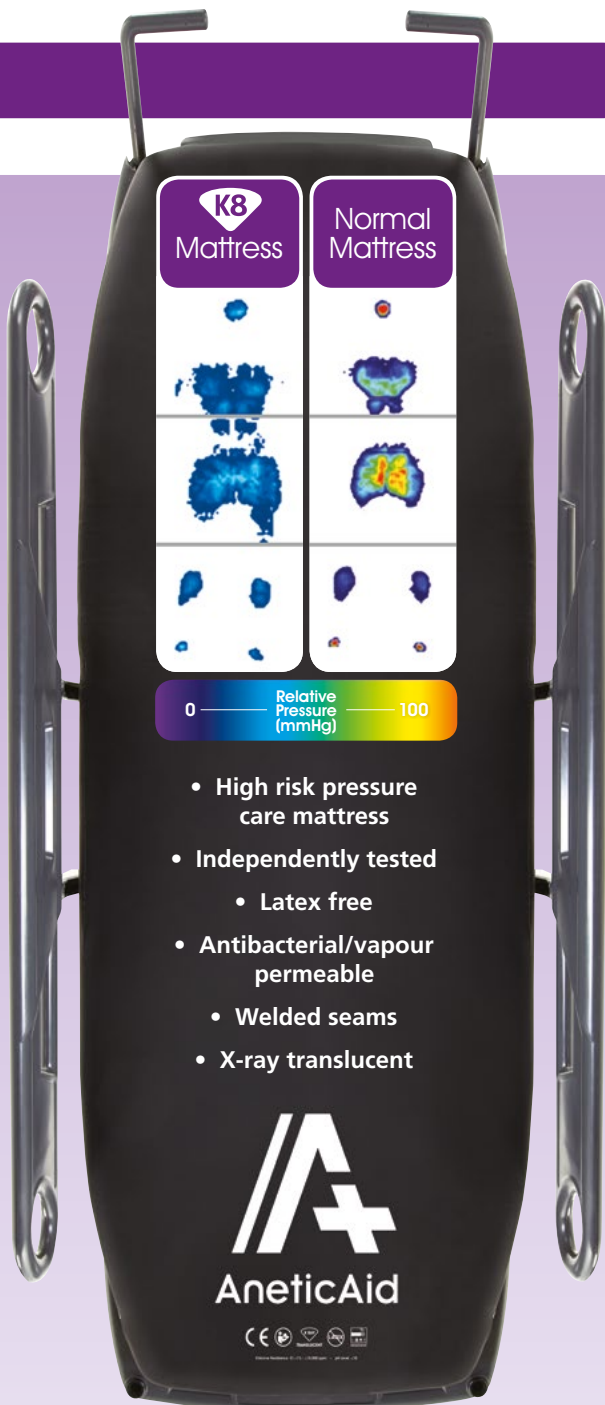

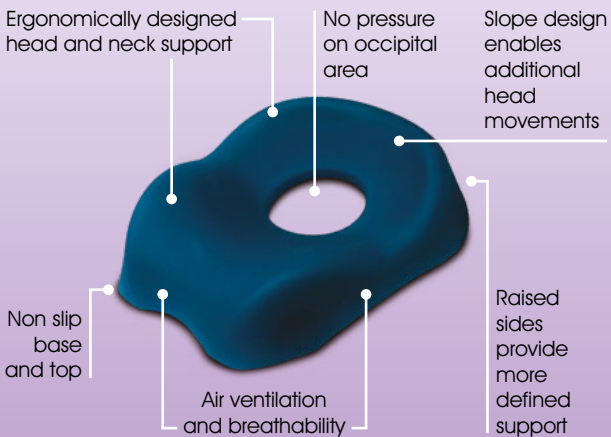

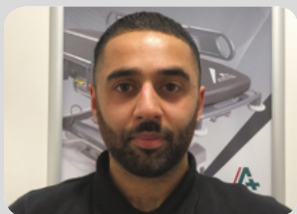
